#### On reduction of MMR and NMR in Vietnam towards the achievement of the Sustainable Development Goals.

The purpose of the assignment is to produce a **situational analysis** of available resources **and mapping** of available services in selected districts that could later lead to the develop detailed plans to **deploy BEmONC, CEmONC and NCU capability at district level** in selected districts.

Duration of the assignment is 59 working days, starting June October 1, 2018

Main tasks of the officer are as follows:

- **Develop Methodology** for the implementation of the assignment and **first draft of the assessment questionnaires forms and guidelines** to be distributed to be filled by provinces and districts.
- Organisation of a first **consultation workshop** as per point 2.2 to explain the questionnaires and guidelines to participants and achieve consensus before distribution of the questionnaires.
- **Distance and in situ support to provincial and district officials** to complete and validate the questionnaires.
- **First draft of the assessment report** including methods, instruments, results, analysis and preliminary conclusions, including any factors that may affect the progress of the assignment.
- Organisation of second **consultation workshop** as per point 2.2 to discuss with the provinces and districts for the revision of **first draft of the assessment report** and development of detailed plan for each selected district on BEmONC, CEmONC, INCU improvement
- **Final Report with conclusions and recommendations** containing sections and details specified in point 2.2.
- Organization of a final **dissemination workshop in Hanoi** to **share the assessment findings and district plans** to provincial, district leaders and all relevant stakeholders, discuss about solutions for implementation of developed plans

## Qualification Requirements

- At least a master degree related to maternal and child care services, primary health care, or health services management. PhD will be an advantage
- A minimum of 10 years of professional experience in the planning, organisation and management of maternal and child care in Viet Nam in different geographical settings
- A minimum of 5 years of professional experience in the planning, organisation and management of maternal and child care at the primary level in Vietnam
- Experience in the development and implementation of improvement programmes in maternal and child care at provincial / district / community levels
- Experience in the monitoring and evaluation of maternal and child care in Viet Nam in different geographical settings
- Experience in the design and use of questionnaires, databases, data compilation cleaning and analysis for health data
- Full fluency in Vietnamese and English, both written and spoken.

All candidates must be computer literate (in spread-sheets and word processing, preferably in Microsoft Word, Excel and Powerpoint), and be fluent in spoken and written English and Vietnamese.
